#### MISSION IN THE VALLEY OF THE RIVER JEQUITINHONHA

On July 1, 2023 we arrived in Jordânia, I Bro. Edenilson, the novices Brothers Arison and Fábio and the aspirant Jone (Francisco). We were welcomed into the community by the brothers Guilherme and Vando for a period of gaining experience in Lar Glorieux (Home for mainly elderly people in need of help) and for a period of living together in the brother house.



In Lar (house) Glorieux we did traditional activities and table games with the residents and we helped with the normal daily activities, together with the staff of the house. We also organized a Festa Junina. June festivities are folkloric celebrations held in June or July with a lot of dancing and singing and in which a fictitious wedding is celebrated. You saw happy faces and a number of singers added luster to the party. Very animated.

We then travelled to the town of Salto da Divisa where we participated in a mission in one of the sections of the parish of São Sebastião. We were very well received by the parish priest Father Paulo Roberto and two postulants Joanderson and Felipe from the Institute of the Little Brothers of the Blessed Sacrament.

The theme of the vocation year *Vocation: Grace and Mission* and the motto *With burning hearts, on foot,* indicated the direction of this missionary action. We were challenged to motivate a somewhat worn-out community, where there was little participation in the activities of the church community, but which was open to receive us and who nevertheless looked to God.

Every day we visited the various families, had meetings with the young people, organized missionary formation, there was adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, there were meetings with the children and prayer celebrations.

#### **DECEASED BUT CERTAINLY NOT FORGOTTEN**

In the diocese of Almenara, the establishment of Caritas Diocesana Almenara is remembered. That was forty years ago. Bro. Piet (Pedro) Goossens and Miss Ana Luiza were the first permanent employees. Both are deceased — Bro. Piet on June 26, 2021 - but are commemorated on this occasion. Because Bro. Piet played such an important role, the brothers had a life sketch made by Frater Henrique Cristiano José Matos in 2022. This beautiful concise overview work that was presented at the General Chapter in Denekamp (the Netherlands) last year is still available. His commitment to Caritas in Almenara is mentioned alongside many other good works.



#### **NEW BISHOP OF ALMENARA**

The Brothers in Brazil have a close relationship with the Diocese of Almenara. Since the establishment of the diocese in 1981, many brothers have worked closely with it. In the early years, these were mainly Bro. Pedro Goossens, Bro. Amado Poppe, Bro. Herbert de Gier and Bro. Marc Etienne.

### **OLD PAPER AND OLD PAPERS**

Feverish activity in the former residence of the Belgian provincial executive: with the motto *everything must go,* people work without stopping to empty rooms and cupboards. Countless hours later, that results in a mountain of old paper. A large part will go to a paper recycling company. Duplicates of books are given a new destination in the libraries of individual interested parties and local history circles.

The old papers, and this means archive, are given a different destination. These are carefully sorted out and sorted in August to be handed over to KADOC, the scientific organization in Leuven (Belgium) that preserves and discloses the monastery archives, this autumn. These documents will then be available for the interested (amateur) historian, until now still after permission from the general executive.

Many words have already been written about the archives of the Congregation. The archives of the Dutch province are kept in the *Heritage Center for Dutch Monastic Life* located in Sint-Agatha. The archives of the Belgian province (including Congo/Zaire) and of the general executive are stored in the cellars of the KADOC.

This archive is divided into two parts, namely the written archive on the one hand and the image archive on the other. By the way, the image archive is one of the more popular archives, according to the research center.
